NEWFOLDEN SUNDAY LIQUOR LICENSE QUESTION

The Newfolden City Council received a request, from a current liquor license holder, to place the question of Sunday Liquor licensing on the August 2024 election ballot.

At this time, the City of Newfolden does not allow Sunday Liquor Licensing. To change this, Minnesota State Statute 340A.504 Subd. 3(d), requires that the question of issuance be placed before the voters of the City of Newfolden.

The City Council approved by resolution that the following language be placed on the August 13, 2024 Primary Election ballot:

“Should the City of Newfolden City Council be allowed to issue on-sale licenses to eligible establishments for the sale of intoxication liquor at retail on Sundays?”

NEWFOLDEN WATER QUALITY AWARD PRESENTED BY U.S CDC!

The Minnesota Department of Health, announced in July that the City of Newfolden has been awarded a Water Fluoridation Quality Award from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Fluoridation is the adjustment of fluoride in drinking water to a level that is effective for preventing tooth decay. The award recognizes those communities that achieved excellence in water fluoridation by maintaining a consistent level of fluoride in drinking water throughout 2022.

For 2022, a total of 1,209 public water systems, in 27 states, received these awards.

“Water fluoridation is one of the best investments that a community can make in maintaining the oral health of its citizens. It is equally effective in preventing cavities in children and adults,” states Casey Hannan, MPD, Director, CDC Division of Oral Health
“Fluoridation is also highly cost effective. Studies continue to show that for every \$1 a community invests in water fluoridation, \$20 are saved in dental treatment costs.”

Community water fluoridation has been recognized by the CDC as one of ten great public health achievement on the 20th century.
